

A workshop of experts on Monitoring and Evaluation of the implementation of the Sharm el Sheikh Commitments on water and sanitation is being organized by AMCOW on the margins of the World Water Week. The workshop scheduled for the 22nd August 2011 is expected to attract participants from AMCOW member countries, RECs and other agencies involved in the sector M&E. The workshop is expected to examine ways of harmonising the water M&E reporting systems in the continent.

The outcomes regarded as critical to carrying out the mandate from the African Union Heads of State and government to AMCOW to operationalize and strengthen the monitoring of the implementation of the Sharm el Sheikh Commitments on water and sanitation, the harmonized reporting format will ensure an effective reporting system on country performances in the sector.
